

Try This Tasty Recipe

VEGETABLE BARLEY SOUP



- 1 medium onion, diced
- 1 tablespoon garlic powder
- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 1/2 lb. carrots (about 4)
- 1 (28-ounce) can unsalted diced tomatoes
- 1 cup pearled barley
- 1 tablespoon dried Italian seasoning
- 6 cups low-sodium vegetable broth
- 1 potato, diced
- 1 cup frozen green beans
- 1/2 cup frozen corn
- 1/2 cup frozen peas

- Heat a large pot over medium heat and add the onion, garlic powder, and olive oil. Cook for 2 to 3 minutes.
- 2. Add carrots, tomatoes, barley, Italian seasoning, and vegetable broth. Stir to combine. Cover with a lid and let soup simmer for 30 minutes.
- **3.** Add diced potato. Cook for 10 minutes, or until potato pieces are tender.
- **4.** Add frozen green beans, corn, and peas. Stir and let cook for another 5 to 10 minutes.
